HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Health Effects

Acute:

SWALLOWED: May cause burns to mouth, throat and gastro intestinal tract.

Storage and Transport: Keep container closed and away from heat and flame. Store in a cool dry place. Must be stored and transported in accordance with State or Territory Regulations.

Spills and Disposal: Absorb spillage on vermiculite or other similar absorbing material. Collect into properly labelled waste containers. Contact local waste authorities with regard to correct disposal. Wash area thoroughly with water.

Fire/Explosion Hazard: Keep away from flammable materials. Moderate fire hazard when exposed to heat or flame.
