HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Health Effects

Acute:

SWALLOWED: Nauseating, irritating to mouth.

EYE: Irritating, can cause conjunctivitis.

SKIN: Irritating on prolonged contact by defatting.

INHALED: Irritating to the respiratory tract.

FIRST AID

SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Do not give patient anything to drink. Obtain medical advice or contact the Poisons Information Centre.

EYE: Do NOT remove contact lenses if worn.

Wash with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes.

SKIN: Remove all contaminated clothing and shoes. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water.

INHALED: Move patient to a well-ventilated area.

Give artificial respiration if the patient is not breathing.

First Aid Facilities: Eye wash. Fresh water.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

EXPOSURE: Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged contact with skin.

VENTILATION: Avoid prolonged exposure to vapour.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Safety wear should be worn at all times. i.e. PVC or rubber gloves & apron also chemical goggles or a face shield.

FLAMMABILITY: Not flammable or combustible

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

STORAGE & TRANSPORT: Dangerous Goods Class 8 – must be stored and transported in accordance with State or Territory dangerous goods regulations. Store in a cool dry place.

SPILLS & DISPOSALS: Absorb spillage on vermiculite or similar absorbing material. Collect into properly labelled waste containers and contact local waste authorities with regard to correct disposal. Wash area thoroughly with water.

FIRE/EXPLOSION HAZARD: Non-flammable.

OTHER INFORMATION:
