

Eco-White

Powdered Chlorine Bleach

LD-104

Eco-White is a professionally formulated powdered laundry bleach designed to use in semi-commercial and commercial laundry machines for removing stains from cotton garments and fabrics. It is also particularly suitable and effective in the removal of obstinate stains from cotton articles using the controlled soak method (also see CAUTION - Page 4).

How To Use

Eco-White is added to the rinse cycle immediately following the wash cycle and the solution maintained at a temperature of 60°C for a minimum of 5 minutes. Additions of Eco-White should be made after the working temperature has been reached. It should be added to the water and not directly onto the fabric.

Dosage

Soak Application

For those stains which persist even after normal machine washing, removal can be achieved by controlled soaking of the garment or fabric in a concentrated bleach solution. In the case of Eco-white a soak concentration of 3 to 4 grams per litre of cold to warm water (up to 45°C) is generally recommended. Such solutions can be made up in a sink or plastic bucket depending on the size or number of articles to be treated. To avoid fabric damage, it is preferable to carry out repeated soakings of the stained articles in the controlled concentrate bleach solution (3 to 4 grams per litre) than to submit them to immersion in a highly concentrated solution for sustained periods of time.

It is important to thoroughly dissolve the Eco-white powder in the water before adding the stained article as concentrations of powder in direct contact with damp or wet fabric may cause marking and damage.

Final Wash

Following the bleach soak, the article "should -be- thoroughly-'rinsed water to remove any remaining bleach solution.

CAUTION

Eco-White is not recommended for use on polyester fabrics. Sheets, gowns, towels or cotton fabrics which have been soiled with solutions of Chlorhexidine must not be washed or soaked in Eco-White or similar Chlorine bleaching agents as the chemical interaction which takes place will cause the formation of permanent stains.
