DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Curcubits	Powdery & Downy Mildew Alternaria Anthracnose Pythium Rot	1:100	Curative: Spray diseased plants using 1:100 Peratec Fungicide for 3 consecutive days and then on 5-7 day intervals. Preventative: Begin when plants are small. Apply first 3 treatments at 1:100 for 5-day intervals. Reduce rate to 1:300 after completion of third treatment and maintain 5 day interval spray cycle until harvest.
